The links take users directly to the website of the media outlet concerned.

Google News is the latest news service to begin using Twitter, which has been embraced by a number of news organizations around the world.

Google in February introduced ads to the results of search queries on [Google News](#) in the United States, in a move aimed at turning the news aggregation site into a money-making venture.
