

Verizon unveils pricing details for iPhone service

(AP) -- Verizon Wireless is revealing details of how much it will charge iPhone users for voice, text and data service.

The company will begin taking preorders for [Apple](#) Inc.'s smart phone on Thursday. Verizon says a basic voice plan including 450 minutes per month will cost \$40.

A voice and text plan including unlimited text messages will start at \$60 per month. And a separate data plan for getting e-mail and the Web will cost \$30 per month.

Verizon says customers will also be able to use the [iPhone](#) as a Wi-Fi hotspot for an extra \$20 per month.

The company is setting aside a limited number of iPhones for those who already subscribe to Verizon. It will begin taking preorders from existing customers at 3 a.m. on Thursday.
