

Japan's Fujifilm to buy US ultrasound maker

Japanese film and camera maker Fujifilm on Thursday announced an agreement to buy SonoSite, a US ultrasound equipment manufacturer, for \$995 million.

Fujifilm, which has been diversifying into healthcare, said it would make an all-cash offer to purchase all outstanding shares of SonoSite common stock through its US subsidiary.

"This transaction significantly accelerates Fujifilm's full-scale entry into the fast-growing hand-carried ultrasound equipment market," President and CEO of <u>Fujifilm</u>, Shigetaka Komori said in a statement.
