

Fiat Chrysler adds nearly 69K Jeeps to side air bag recall

Fiat Chrysler is adding almost 69,000 Jeep Cherokees to a recall to fix software that can cause side air bags to inflate without a crash.

The addition brings the total number of 2014 and 2015 Cherokees covered by the February <u>recall</u> to nearly 317,000. All but 52,000 are in the U.S., Canada or Mexico.

Dealers will upgrade <u>software</u> that controls side curtain and seatmounted side air bags. Fiat Chrysler says there have been a small number of inadvertent air bag deployments, mostly in off-road conditions. They happened when the Jeeps' angle of operation changed, causing the system to sense a possible rollover and inflate the air bags.

The company says dealers will recalibrate the threshold that sets off the <u>air bags</u>. It knows of no crashes or injuries.
