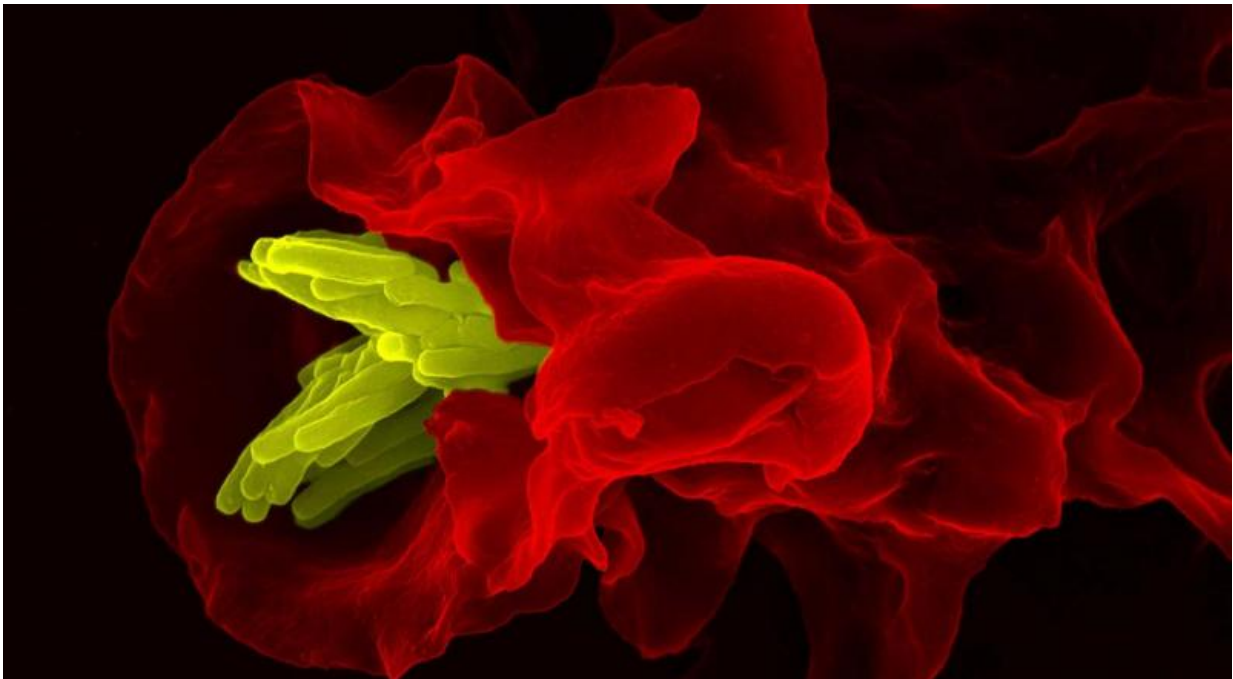


Video: Why are we still fighting tuberculosis?
