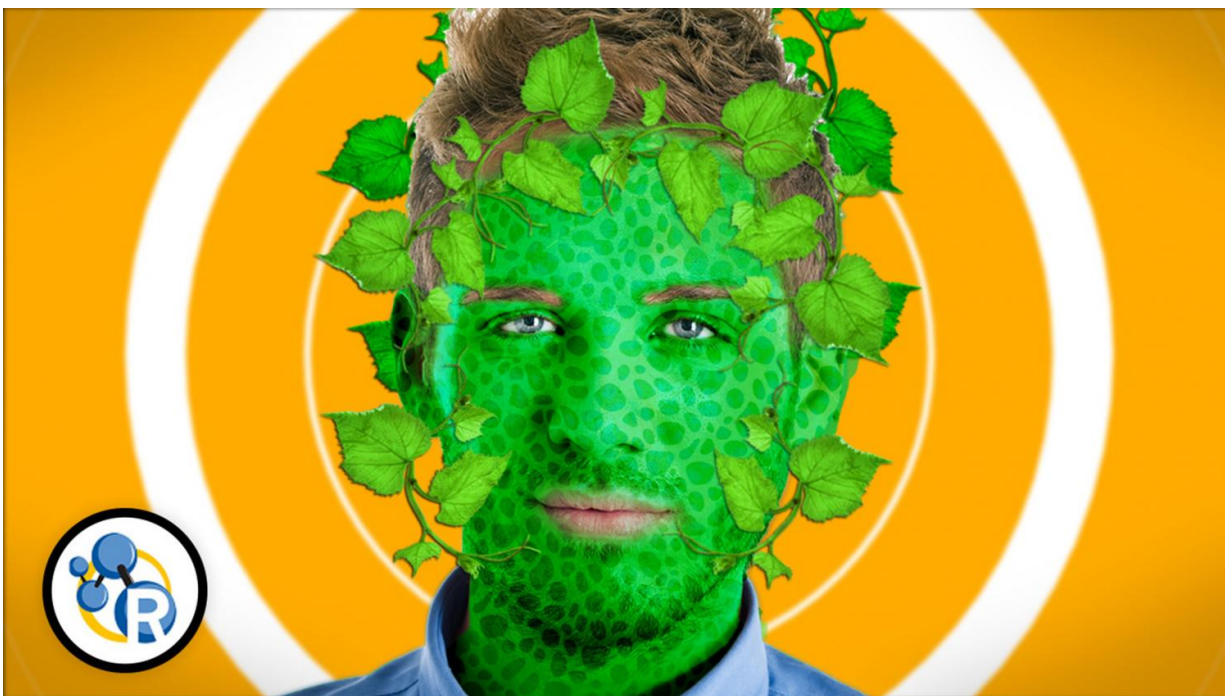


Video: What if humans could photosynthesize?
