

Esquire network will transition from cable to online channel

Esquire Network said Wednesday it is shutting down as a cable channel and will transition into a digital online outlet.

The Esquire online network will launch this spring, around the time the <u>cable channel</u> goes dark.

The TV channel had struggled as major cable providers dropped it from their lineups.

A partnership of NBCUniversal and Hearst Magazines, the network began in 2013 in a <u>rebranding</u> of what had been Style Network.

It was conceived as a TV brand extension of Hearst's young-menoriented Esquire magazine.
