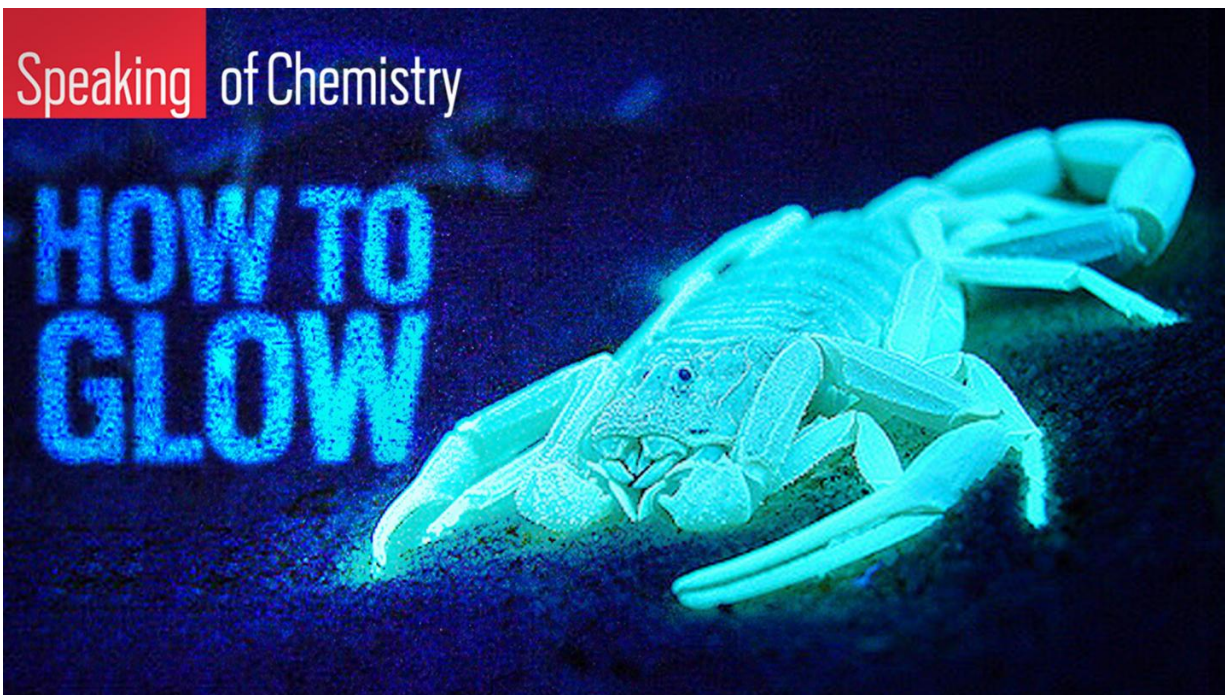


Video: How animals glow
