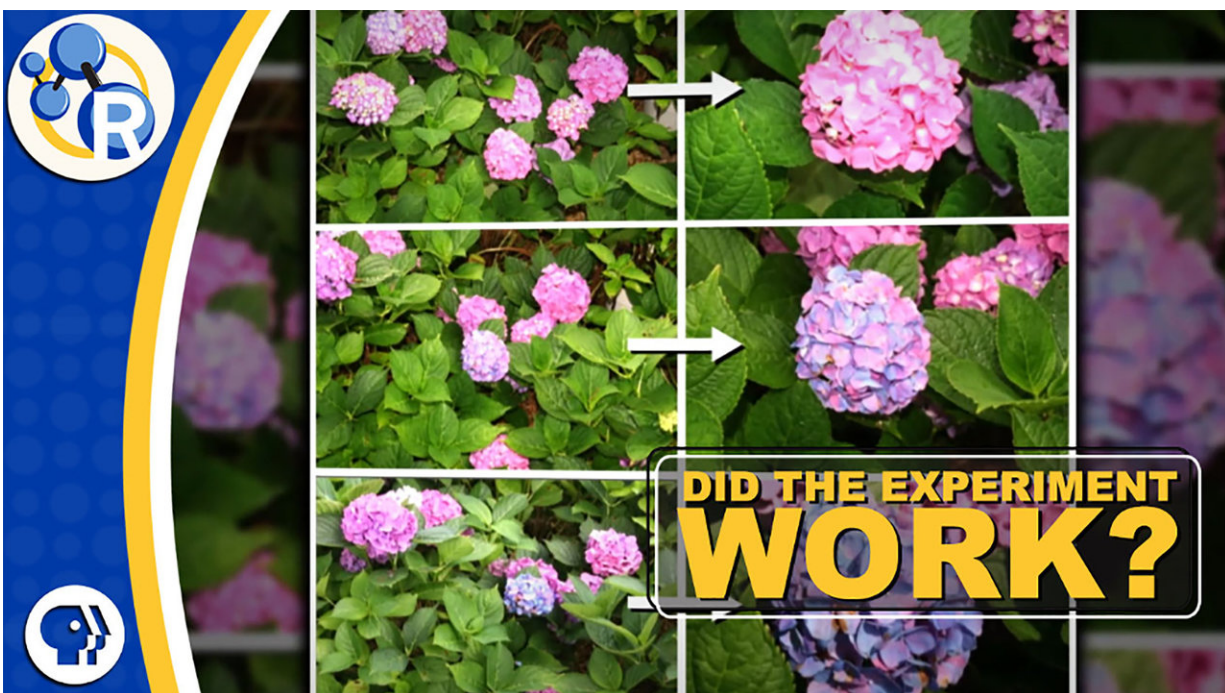


Video: Hydrangeas and the science of do-overs
