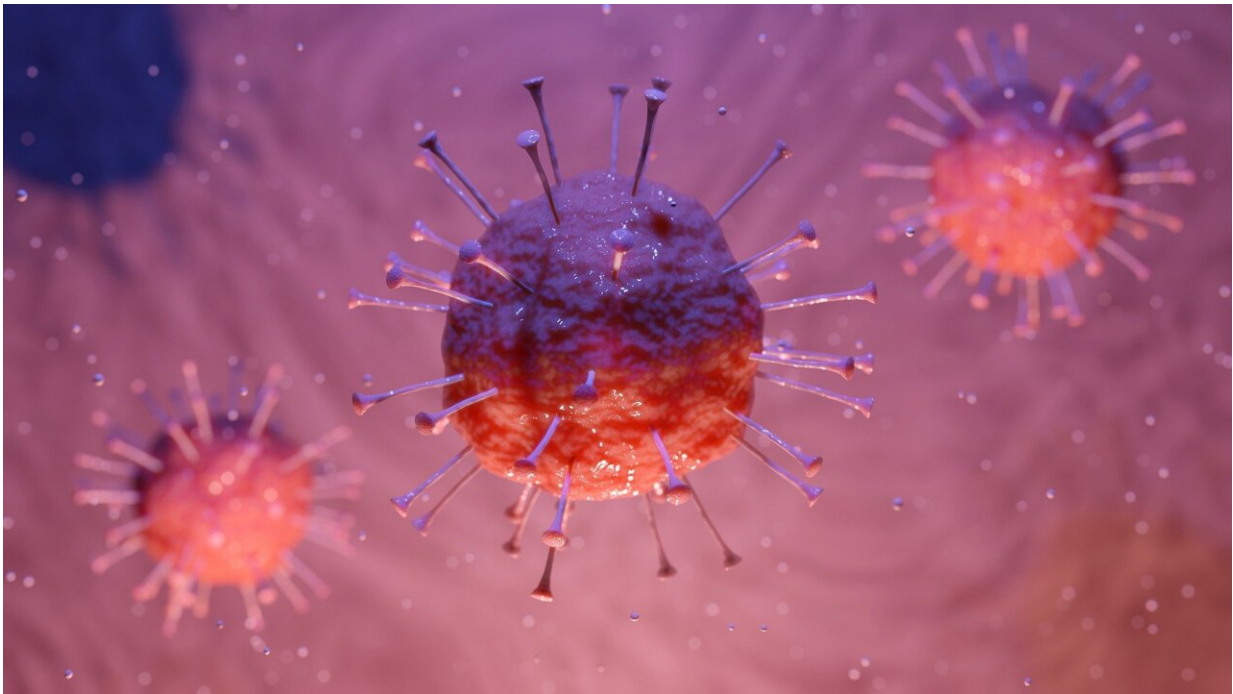


Video: How COVID-19 is affecting support for mail-in voting
