


## Researchers examine career confidence in underrepresented biomedical scientist trainees

Main effects of gender, race/ethnicity, career interest, and seniority. All main variables showed a significant effect on self-career efficacy, with the exception of seniority, which was trending but not significant. A four-way ANOVA of gender, race/ethnicity, career interest, and seniority on the level of CSE showed significant main effects for each variable. P-values indicate the main effects for each variable of interest, \*\*\*\*p
